## Hair (Prep - Year 12)

| - Tinting, colouring and dyeing of hair are not permitted in the Primary school <br> - Senior school girls may colour their hair so that it remains natural looking without any bold or unnatural colours or streaks <br> - Hair which is cut extremely short is not acceptable <br> - Hair which touches the collar must be tied back <br> - Fringes must be kept out of the eyes <br> - The wearing of novelty clips and hair accessories is unsuitable | - Head shaving shorter than number 2 and partial head shaving is unsuitable <br> - Hair is to be above the shirt collar and out of the eyes. Hair which touches the collar must be tied back <br> - Unkempt hair is unsuitable <br> - Tinting, colouring and dyeing of hair are not permitted in the Primary school <br> - Senior boys may colour their hair so that it remains natural looking without any bold or unnatural colours or streaks <br> - Fringes must be kept out of the eyes |

## Jewellery (Prep - Year 12)

| - Sleepers and plain gold or silver studs are the only permissible jewellery (maximum of two in each ear positioned appropriately in the lobe). <br> - Except for a watch and one signet ring, the wearing of all other jewellery, including necklaces is unsuitable <br> - No body studs (including nose piercings) are allowed <br> - Piercings additional to approved piercings must have a clear spacer worn so they are not visible | - The wearing of earrings is unsuitable. <br> - Except for a watch, the wearing of jewellery is unsuitable <br> - No body studs are allowed |

## Makeup and Nail Polish (Prep - Year 12)

## All Students

- The wearing of makeup is not permitted. Senior school girls may wear natural looking foundation or powder but this cannot be heavy, unnatural or obvious in appearance.
- Clear nail enamel / polish may be worn however fake nails, French tips or any coloured or glitter nail enamel / polish is unsuitable


## Free Dress Policy (Prep - Year 12)

Occasionally students will be allowed to wear "Free Dress" as a fun day, or in support of a charity or cause. On these days, the following rules will apply:

## All Students

- Free Dress affects clothing only. Makeup and jewellery must follow the Uniform Policy.
- Free Dress must be neat and tidy.
- Free Dress needs to be modest: must cover the midriff; skirts, shorts and dresses must be longer than fingertips when arms are by the side (fingertip rule); must have appropriate height for necklines and must not be see through.
- Free Dress must adhere to the College values (eg: No inappropriate slogans on t-shirts)
- Free Dress needs to be suitable to wear in all the normal curriculum areas (eg: Closed-in shoes, no high heels). If a student has lessons in Hospitality, Science, Design \& Technology or Art, they must wear or bring their leather school shoes for practical lessons.
- Clothing must allow freedom to perform their usual classroom work and other activities.
- Sun safety rules still apply - students must wear hats, and all students must have shoulders covered (no singlets or straps).
- Girls may wear their hair out for free dress days, provided that they have the means to tie hair back for subjects / activities that require it.
- Please note that students cannot 'pick and choose' with Free Dress Day uniform. Eg: students cannot wear their College Sport uniform with Free Dress shoes, or wear a Free Dress shirt with their College shorts or skirt/skort. Students must choose to wear the full correct uniform, or full Free Dress clothing.
